MINUTES OF MEETING FALCON TRACE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

The regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the Falcon Trace Community Development District was held Wednesday, July 15, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. via Zoom Video Conferencing, pursuant to Executive Orders 20-52, 20-69, 20-112, and 20-150 issued by Governor DeSantis on March 9, 2020, March 20, 2020, April 29, 2020, and June 23, 2020 respectively, and any extensions or supplements thereof, and pursuant to Section 120.54(5)(b)2., Florida Statutes.

The following is a summary of the discussions and actions taken at the July 15, 2020 meeting. A copy of the proceedings can be obtained by contacting the District Manager.

FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS Roll Call

Mr. Showe called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and called the roll.

SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS Public Comment Period

There being none, the next item followed.

THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS

Approval of the Minutes of the June 2, 2020 Meeting

On MOTION by Ms. Baron seconded by Ms. Stark with all in favor the minutes of the June 2, 2020 meeting were approved as presented.

FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Release and Satisfaction of Lien for Series 2007 Special Assessments

Mr. Showe stated those assessments have been satisfied as of May and this was drafted by Counsel and will be recorded and attached to each of the parcels indicating that lien has been paid.

Mr. Eckert stated we did receive the release of bonds from the trustee so that resolves our relationship with the actual bondholders and trustee and what this does is puts on record that none of the homes within Falcon Trace have any more debt assessments at this point in time and we recommend approval.

On MOTION by Ms. Hurst seconded by Ms. Baron with all in favor the Release and Satisfaction of Lien for the Series 2007 Special Assessments was approved.

FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Discussion of Dock Rules

Mr. Showe stated when we talked about the reopening of the facility we discussed that we don't really have rules for the dock and lake area formally adopted by the Board. Included in your agenda package is a sample policy from another District, Narcoossee, and in essence they say no swimming, bathing or wading and it is only for recreational purposes and they haven't put a lot of limitations as to what types of boats can go in there. We thought this might be a good place to start the discussion and get input from the Board on what you would like.

Ms. Hurst asked do you know how large this lake is compared to ours?

Mr. Showe responded it is probably about half the size. It is comparable, it is in the same County and falls under the same general permit restrictions. This is a good place to start and get some feedback.

Ms. Hurst stated the whole fishing area would be eliminated from our policy. I don't think we want to have anything to do with fishing in our waterways.

Ms. Miller stated they reference a townhouse and that needs to come out because we just want to assign it to the homeowners of Falcon Trace and townhouses is not for our community. Can we limit the number of crafts on the water?

Mr. Showe stated you could, but I don't know how you would enforce that.

Ms. Hurst stated some lots go into the water and we can't say you can't go out because somebody has come to the boat dock and is already on the water. There is no way to manage that. You could say only two people could enter from the boat dock area, but you wouldn't be able to control the homeowners that live along that one side.

Mr. Shaikh joined the meeting at this time.

Ms. Hurst stated my husband said our boat dock is unsuitable for kayaks. At Shingle Creek they have a floating boat dock that can be used for kayaks. Do we put one in first or ask the residents if that is something they would use then put it in? We would have to come to a consensus. I did send Jason a couple of notes about how to maintain some sort of controls on people who access it so Dave and the pool attendants didn't have to sit and wait for things all the time, maybe we could have a key on a floating keychain, so they could check the key out on your pool pass so you know who had the key and if it didn't come back you could charge them and if the key fell overboard it would float. All the things that concern me is that this is a natural waterway, there are snakes and alligators, all kinds of stuff and I don't want us to be held liable for anybody who gets injured in any way, shape or form. I don't want us to take on additional liability if we don't know if people really want this.

Ms. Baron asked what would our liability be?

Mr. Eckert stated I think the best course of action would be if you are aware of dangerous animals to have some signage regarding the dangerous animals. That is something that is thought of as a best practice if you have actual knowledge of dangerous animals in the area. In terms of holding the dock & lake out for people to go and kayak I don't see potential liability necessarily as a reason why you shouldn't do it. If somebody is drunk and they are out there and drown then the District has a defense to that case. If they are just negligent and they drown the District has a defense to that case. I would not say from a liability standpoint that you shouldn't allow anybody whatsoever, but I think you have to make the decision do we want to allow boating and then

under what circumstances. Our other concern is to make sure that whatever rules you come up with and things that you allow are consistent with the permit that governs that area. I have seen some permits in the past that say, no boating or boating is restricted to certain types of boats and that is actually in the permit. My guess is what you are looking at as an example, because we represent Narcoossee as well, is an example of what is actually allowed in the permit but you want to verify that because every project is a little bit different.

Ms. Baron stated I like the idea of having boating on that lake. That is a big plus for having that lake, but I would like to hear from the attendants who are really there, what they think about having boating.

Ms. Hurst stated you are only talking about human powered boating, no boats with motors.

Ms. Baron asked would we allow battery powered? I know we don't want gas.

Ms. Hurst stated we don't want gas.

Mr. Showe stated the Narcoossee Board chose to allow battery powered because they were concerned about fuel getting into the lake. That will come down to checking the permit and Board preference if it is allowed.

Ms. Baron stated we can figure out if we want battery or not.

Ms. Hurst stated canoes, kayaks, paddle boards, are things that I don't think anyone would mind seeing if they looked out their back windows because it wouldn't be disruptive. Dave, have you had anyone express interest in going to use the boat dock? I know you put up a sign after the last meeting.

Mr. Tuel stated we had one guy with a kayak last week and he didn't want to use the boat ramp, he brought the kayak down next to the dock and put it in the water. The whole time I have been there only one person asked to use the boat dock.

Mr. Viasalyers stated I have seen more people put in a boat by the roundabout than by the dock.

Ms. Hurst stated we need to think about signage even by the roundabout even though that is owned by the HOA.

Ms. Baron stated the HOA would have to vote on it, but I can't imagine that we would mind putting a sign there. When we decide I can bring it to the board of directors.

Mr. Showe stated we will provide the wording for the signs. The decision for the Board is what type of boats would you want out there if any, and fishing. Once you make those decisions we can put together a policy.

Ms. Hurst stated the only reason I didn't think we wanted fishing was because of the carp that we had in the lake although I don't know that they are still there.

Mr. Showe stated I think they get replenished every year or so and the vendor can add once he determines how many are still out there.

- Mr. Shaikh asked would this allow a small sailboat?
- Mr. Showe stated that is up to the Board to make that determination.
- Mr. Tuel stated four or five people fish there every day, they enjoy it and look forward to it. They don't keep the fish they catch and release.
 - Ms. Hurst stated that's okay with me.
 - Ms. Baron stated that is something to take into consideration to allow catch and release.
 - Mr. Showe stated we will get the permit and make sure we know the permit rules.

SIXTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Staff Reports

A. Attorney

Mr. Eckert stated the ability for us to meet electronically is set to expire August 1st. We anticipate that will probably be extended and we will let the Board know if that gets extended.

B. Manager

i. Approval of Check Register

On MOTION by Ms. Hurst seconded by Ms. Baron with all in favor the check register was approved.

ii. Balance Sheet and Income Statement

A copy of the financials was included in the agenda package.

iii. Action Items List

A copy of the action items list was included in the agenda package.

iv. Field Manager's Report

Mr. Viasalyers stated we had some warranty issues with the lighting in the parking lot with the new LED conversion. The vendor sent the four lights out under warranty and the replacements should be received in the next week or so.

I'm working with Varsity Courts to get a price to enclose the tennis court and basketball court and getting a price from ACT to put the key fob swipes on the basketball court as well. We are working with vendors to get prices for the bench and other items that were requested.

Ms. Miller asked did we have a lightning strike that damaged the camera or computer?

Mr. Viasalyers stated yes, there was a lightning strike that did crash the computer and camera system and internet. The camera system was fine, the only thing damaged was the modem, printer and computer. I believe it has been replaced but I haven't seen the invoice.

Ms. Miller asked did we get estimates?

Mr. Viasalyers stated I think it was a situation where they needed to be sure they could let guests in and out properly because the gate was unlocked. It would be impossible to monitor that with it not being locked.

Mr. Showe stated we used our IT staff that does all the repairs for GMS to make sure there were no delay, but I will follow-up with them and get the cost and make sure it is in line with what you would have paid.

Ms. Miller stated we also had an issue with the pool pump.

Mr. Viasalyers stated that has been repaired. It went down on Sunday and we shut the pool and that has been taken care of. Spies came out Monday morning and took care of that.

Ms. Miller asked how are we doing with sanitizing?

Mr. Viasalyers stated I think it is going well, I haven't had any issues.

Mr. Tuel stated they are there twice a day, 8:00 a.m. and then at 3:00 p.m. They do a good job of spraying everything and cleaning everything.

Mr. Viasalyers stated we had an issue with the fan blower in the a/c in the club room went out and a vendor came out today and replaced it.

Ms. Miller asked when are we going to power wash the basketball court?

Mr. Viasalyers stated I think there was a misunderstanding with the vendor on that process and we are waiting for them to finish the boxes and if not Dave's crew will do a soft pressure wash and paint those. Hopefully, within the next couple of weeks that will be done.

Ms. Hurst stated I have seen people at the tennis courts. Are we having a lot of usage or is it just every now and then?

- Mr. Tuel stated they are playing tennis every day.
- Mr. Shaikh asked are the tennis lights on a meter then can turn on and off?
- Mr. Viasalyers responded it is on a timer that was recently replaced because the old one was no longer working.

SEVENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Supervisor's Requests

Mr. Shaikh stated our facilities look good and staff gets credit for it.

RESOLUTION 2020-07

THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION OF THE FALCON TRACE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT ("DISTRICT") RELATING TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS AND ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2020, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2021; AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the District Manager has, prior to the fifteenth (15th) day in June 2020, submitted to the Board of Supervisors ("Board") of the Falcon Trace Community Development District ("District") a proposed budget ("Proposed Budget") for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020, and ending September 30, 2021 ("Fiscal Year 2020/2021") along with an explanatory and complete financial plan for each fund of the District, pursuant to the provisions of Section 190.008(2)(a), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, at least sixty (60) days prior to the adoption of the Proposed Budget, the District filed a copy of the Proposed Budget with the local governing authorities having jurisdiction over the area included in the District pursuant to the provisions of Section 190.008(2)(b), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Board set a public hearing thereon and caused notice of such public hearing to be given by publication pursuant to Section 190.008(2)(a), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the District Manager posted the Proposed Budget on the District's website at least two days before the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, Section 190.008(2)(a), Florida Statutes, requires that, prior to October 1st of each year, the Board, by passage of the Annual Appropriation Resolution, shall adopt a budget for the ensuing fiscal year and appropriate such sums of money as the Board deems necessary to defray all expenditures of the District during the ensuing fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the District Manager has prepared a Proposed Budget, whereby the budget shall project the cash receipts and disbursements anticipated during a given time period, including reserves for contingencies for emergency or other unanticipated expenditures during the fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE FALCON TRACE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT:

SECTION 1. BUDGET

a. The Board has reviewed the Proposed Budget, a copy of which is on file with the office of the District Manager and at the District's Local Records Office, and hereby approves certain amendments thereto, as shown in Section 2 below.

- b. The Proposed Budget, attached hereto as **Exhibit "A,"** as amended by the Board, is hereby adopted in accordance with the provisions of Section 190.008(2)(a), *Florida Statutes* ("**Adopted Budget"**), and incorporated herein by reference; provided, however, that the comparative figures contained in the Adopted Budget may be subsequently revised as deemed necessary by the District Manager to reflect actual revenues and expenditures.
- c. The Adopted Budget, as amended, shall be maintained in the office of the District Manager and at the District's Local Records Office and identified as "The Budget for the Falcon Trace Community Development District for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 2021."
- d. The Adopted Budget shall be posted by the District Manager on the District's official website within thirty (30) days after adoption, and shall remain on the website for at least 2 years.

SECTION 3. BUDGET AMENDMENTS

Pursuant to Section 189.016, *Florida Statutes*, the District at any time within Fiscal Year 2020/2021 or within 60 days following the end of the Fiscal Year 2020/2021 may amend its Adopted Budget for that fiscal year as follows:

- a. The Board may authorize an increase or decrease in line item appropriations within a fund by motion recorded in the minutes if the total appropriations of the fund do not increase.
- b. The District Manager or Treasurer may authorize an increase or decrease in line item appropriations within a fund if the total appropriations of the fund do not increase and if the aggregate change in the original appropriation item does not exceed \$10,000 or 10% of the original appropriation.

- c. By resolution, the Board may increase any appropriation item and/or fund to reflect receipt of any additional unbudgeted monies and make the corresponding change to appropriations or the unappropriated balance.
- d. Any other budget amendments shall be adopted by resolution and consistent with Florida law.

The District Manager or Treasurer must establish administrative procedures to ensure that any budget amendments are in compliance with this Section 3 and Section 189.016, *Florida Statutes*, among other applicable laws. Among other procedures, the District Manager or Treasurer must ensure that any amendments to budget under subparagraphs c. and d. above are posted on the District's website within 5 days after adoption and remain on the website for at least 2 years.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

REVENUES:

MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENTS

The District will levy a Non-Ad Valorem assessment on all of the assessable property within the District in order to pay for the operating expenditures during the fiscal year.

MISCELLANEOUS INCOME

The District will receive income from guest fees, including rental income and pool access cards.

INTEREST INCOME

The District earns interest income on their operating accounts and other investments.

EXPENDITURES:

ADMINISTRATIVE:

SUPERVISORS FEES

The Florida Statutes allows each supervisor to be paid per meeting, for the time devoted to District business and board meetings. The amount for the fiscal year is based upon 5 supervisors attending 8 monthly meetings.

FICA EXPENSE

Represents the Employer's share of Social Security and Medicare taxes withheld from Board of Supervisors checks.

ENGINEERING FEES

Estimated cost for providing general engineering services to the District on an as needed basis as directed by the Board of Supervisors.

ASSESSMENT ROLL

The District has contracted with Governmental Management Services - Central Florida, LLC. to levy and administer the collection of a Non-Ad Valorem assessment on all assessable property within the District.

ATTORNEY FEES

The District's attorney will be providing general legal services to the District, e.g., attendance and preparation for monthly meetings, reviewing contracts, agreements, resolutions, etc.

ANNUAL AUDIT

The District is required by Florida Statutes to arrange for an independent audit of its financial records on an annual basis. The District's auditing firm is Grau & Associates.

MANAGEMENT FEES

The District has contracted with Governmental Management Services-Central Florida, LLC to provide Management, Accounting and Recording Secretary Services for the District. The services include, but not limited to, recording and transcription of board meetings, administrative services, budget preparation, all financial reporting, annual audits, etc.

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

The District incurs costs related to the District's accounting and information systems, website creation and maintenance, electronic compliance with Florida Statutes and other electronic data requirements.

TELEPHONE

The District incurs charges for telephone and facsimile services.

POSTAGE

Mailing of Board meeting agenda packages, overnight deliveries, checks for vendors and any other required correspondence.

PRINTING AND BINDING

Printing and binding agenda packages for board meetings, printing of computerized checks, correspondence, stationary, etc.

INSURANCE

The District's general liability and public officials liability insurance coverage is provided by the Florida Insurance Alliance (FIA). FIA specializes in providing insurance coverage to governmental agencies.

LEGAL ADVERTISING

Advertising of monthly board meetings, public hearings, and any services that are required to be advertised for public bidding, i.e. audit services, engineering service, maintenance contracts and any other advertising that may be required.

CONTINGENCY

Represents estimated bank charges and any other miscellaneous charges that the District may incur during the fiscal year.

PROPERTY APPRAISER

Represents the fees to be paid to the Orange County Property Appraiser's office for assessment administration services.

OFFICE SUPPLIES

The District incurs charges for supplies that need to be purchased during the fiscal year, including copier and printer toner cartridges, paper, file folders, binders, pens, paper clips, and other such office supplies.

DUES, LICENSES, & SUBSCRIPTIONS

The District is required to pay an annual fee to the Department of Economic Opportunities for \$175. This is the only expense under this category for the District.

MAINTENANCE:

FIELD MANAGEMENT

Provide onsite field management of contracts for the District per the management consulting contract with Governmental Management Services - Central Florida, LLC. Services to include onsite inspections, meetings with contractors, monitoring of utility accounts, attend Board meetings and receive and respond to property owner phone calls and emails.

PROPERTY INSURANCE

The District's property insurance coverage is provided by Florida Insurance Alliance (FIA). FIA specializes in providing insurance coverage to governmental agencies.

POOL STAFF PAYROLL

The District has contracted with Governmental Management Services - Central Florida, LLC. to hire and supervise pool attendants; coordinate all facility operations and be the contact point for answering questions and solving problems for residents. Account line includes staff hours for the fiscal year, all related benefits, and a contingency for projects and a pay increase.

SECURITY

This represents the cost of monthly monitoring of the security system to the recreation center.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE FALCON TRACE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT MAKING A **DETERMINATION** OF BENEFIT AND **IMPOSING SPECIAL** ASSESSMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020/2021; PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION AND ENFORCEMENT OF SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS: CERTIFYING AN ASSESSMENT **ROLL: PROVIDING** AMENDMENTS TO THE ASSESSMENT ROLL; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Falcon Trace Community Development District ("District") is a local unit of special-purpose government established pursuant to Chapter 190, *Florida Statutes*, for the purpose of providing, operating and maintaining infrastructure improvements, facilities and services to the lands within the District; and

WHEREAS, the District is located in Orange County, Florida ("County"); and

WHEREAS, the District has constructed or acquired various infrastructure improvements and provides certain services in accordance with the District's adopted capital improvement plan and Chapter 190, *Florida Statutes*; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors ("Board") of the District hereby determines to undertake various operations and maintenance and other activities described in the District's budget ("Adopted Budget") for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020 and ending September 30, 2021 ("Fiscal Year 2020/2021"), attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference herein; and

WHEREAS, the District must obtain sufficient funds to provide for the operation and maintenance of the services and facilities provided by the District as described in the Adopted Budget; and

WHEREAS, the provision of such services, facilities, and operations is a benefit to lands within the District; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 190, *Florida Statutes*, provides that the District may impose special assessments on benefitted lands within the District; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the District to proceed with the imposition of the special assessments for operations and maintenance in the amount set forth in the Adopted Budget; and

WHEREAS, the District has previously levied an assessment for debt service, which the District desires to collect for Fiscal Year 2020/2021; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 197, Florida Statutes, provides a mechanism pursuant to which such

special assessments may be placed on the tax roll and collected by the local tax collector ("Uniform Method"), and the District has previously authorized the use of the Uniform Method by, among other things, entering into agreements with the Property Appraiser and Tax Collector of the County for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the District to adopt the Assessment Roll of the Falcon Trace Community Development District ("Assessment Roll") attached to this Resolution as Exhibit B and incorporated as a material part of this Resolution by this reference, and to certify the Assessment Roll to the County Tax Collector pursuant to the Uniform Method; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the District to permit the District Manager to amend the Assessment Roll, certified to the County Tax Collector by this Resolution, as the Property Appraiser updates the property roll for the County, for such time as authorized by Florida law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE FALCON TRACE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT:

SECTION 1. BENEFIT & ALLOCATION FINDINGS. The Board hereby finds and determines that the provision of the services, facilities, and operations as described in **Exhibit A** confers a special and peculiar benefit to the lands within the District, which benefit exceeds or equals the cost of the assessments. The allocation of the assessments to the specially benefitted lands, as shown in **Exhibits A and B**, is hereby found to be fair and reasonable.

SECTION 2. ASSESSMENT IMPOSITION. Pursuant to Chapters 190 and 197, *Florida Statutes*, and using the procedures authorized by Florida law for the levy and collection of special assessments, a special assessment for operation and maintenance is hereby imposed and levied on benefitted lands within the District, and in accordance with **Exhibits A and B.** The lien of the special assessments for operations and maintenance imposed and levied by this Resolution shall be effective upon passage of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. COLLECTION. The collection of the operation and maintenance special assessments and previously levied debt service assessments shall be at the same time and in the same manner as County taxes in accordance with the Uniform Method, as indicated on **Exhibits A and B.** The decision to collect special assessments by any particular method - e.g., on the tax roll or by direct bill - does not mean that such method will be used to collect special assessments in future years, and the District reserves the right in its sole discretion to select collection methods in any given year, regardless of past practices.

SECTION 4. ASSESSMENT ROLL. The Assessment Roll, attached to this Resolution as **Exhibit B,** is hereby certified to the County Tax Collector and shall be collected by the County Tax Collector in the same manner and time as County taxes. The proceeds therefrom shall be paid to the District.

SECTION 5. ASSESSMENT ROLL AMENDMENT. The District Manager shall keep

apprised of all updates made to the County property roll by the Property Appraiser after the date of this Resolution, and shall amend the Assessment Roll in accordance with any such updates, for such time as authorized by Florida law, to the County property roll. After any amendment of the Assessment Roll, the District Manager shall file the updates in the District records.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. The invalidity or unenforceability of any one or more provisions of this Resolution shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining portions of this Resolution, or any part thereof.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect upon the passage and adoption of this Resolution by the Board.
